Instruction leaflet for GroundGuard Tiles - Gravel



- Clear the area of debris prior to installation.
- Measure area for correct number of ground tiles required. NB. Each pack of 20 = 3.04 square metres.



Prepare ground and make level. Put down a layer of Type 1, 15 cm deep.



Lay a membrane.



Put down a layer of sand 2 cm deep.




Clip tiles together, allowing for any cut sections to be the furthest away from heavily trafficked areas.



Ensure the spike is pressed into the ground. Tiles may be cut to size using a suitable saw or knife.



Finally, fill with 8-10 mm gravel or pea shingle.



To remove, expose the locking element and use a flat head screwdriver to leaver away from the adjacent tile. Replace accordingly, clipping together as

per step 4.

- Only suitable for pedestrian areas and light vehicle access.
